- (i) Good academic record with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level in a relevant subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university
- (ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or a similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET.

Note i. The candidates, who are admitted/awarded the Ph.D. degree prior to 11th July, 2009 or have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 as amended from time to time shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET.
ii. NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted

MUSIC

- (i) Good academic record with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level in a relevant subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university
- (ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or a similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET.

- (a) Ph.D. degree of the candidate awarded in regular mode only;
- (b) Evaluation of the Ph.D. thesis by at least two external examiners;
- (c) Open Ph.D. viva-voce of the candidate had been conducted.

First Class Master's Degree in Business Management/Administration in a relevant management related discipline or first class in two years full time PGDM declared equivalent by AIU / accredited by the AICTE / UGC;

First Class Graduate and professionally qualified Chartered Accountant/ Cost and Work Accountant/ Company Secretary of the concerned statutory body.

GENERAL NOTE:

GOOD ACADMIC RECORD

Good academic record means at least IInd Division either at secondary or Sr. Secondary / Higher Secondary level and at graduate level.

1. A relaxation of 5% will be given at the graduate and master's level for the Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/Differently-abled (Physically and visually/differently-abled) categories for the purpose of eligibility and for assessing good academic record during direct recruitment to teaching positions. The eligibility marks of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based on only the qualifying marks without including any grace mark.
2. A relaxation of 5% may be provided, from 55% to 50% of the marks to the Ph.D. Degree holders, who have obtained their Master's Degree prior to 19 September, 1991.

SEVEN POINTS SCALE:

It is clarified that where the University/ College /Institution declare results in grade points which is on a scale of seven, the following mechanism will be referred to ascertain equivalent marks in percentage:
